5) Update from Fiona

- October is busy.
- Looked at modular requests for gov't. 22 additional for RVS. 7 for Cochrane. Gov't asked to fund the move of 12 additional modulars from Langdon and Indus. Total of 32. Requested for any schools at or over 100%. Likely won't hear back until early Spring from gov't.
- 5 modulars were approved from last year's request but not in place yet
- November- budgets and audits. RVS aware they will not be ending in as strong as financial position as had hoped. Some expenditures came in higher than expected. Reserves in 1-3% of operating budget. Means that there will be adjustments to budgets.
- EB getting additional dollars from what told last spring.
- Did not reach projections for enrollment (approx. 100 students less than projected). \$ Allotment based on per student.
- Weighted moving average: have been through full cycle (3-years). Underfunded by almost \$5M for RVS.
- Covid dollars (targeted grants) have not been announced yet and nothing received.
- Joint Board Student Council meeting. Presentation on PBIS. Next is on March 14, 2024.
- Board meeting tomorrow: Annual education results will come to board tomorrow. Satisfaction results. How we are meeting goals, accountability, etc.

- Discussion around ward boundaries (municipal election). Any changes need to be arranged in the next year in prep for election.
- AGM and conference Sun-Tues this next week- working with provincial school boards.
- Chantelle asked: where modulars are going- 3 at Fireside, 2 at CHS, 2 at CCA.
